Schedule Change:

- Due to the growing unrest in the Middle East and the recent plot by terrorists to blow up airplanes bound for the USA, Baptists Equipping Nationals has decided to reschedule our Egypt Trip for January. The US Government discouraged travel to that part of the world at this time. Please continue to pray for our students. Recent anti-American (and anti-Christian) demonstrations in Egypt have made that region highly unstable and unsafe for traveling, and the persecution of national Christians in mounting.
- As it stands now, the trip that was planned for September 17 has been moved to January 28.

P. S. Last week I printed this amazing story. Several new subscribers wanted it in print, so I am adding here as a post script.

The Church in the Cemetery ...

Bassem, one of my best and brightest students, wanted to plant a church in New Cairo, Egypt. But there was a problem. In New Cairo no church buildings are allowed (although a mosque could be built on every corner). New Cairo is growing fast. Over 10,000 new apartments are being built in this city. The project is called the *Susan Mubarac Youth Complex*. Young couples who marry are provided a place to live. What a great mission field this is! But the officials would not give Bassam permission to build a meeting place for his church in the city limits. That is, until Bassam discovered a technicality in the zoning law: it is legal to erect a church building in a cemetery! The Evangelical Cemetery is right across the street from the new apartments. So now, permission has been granted for the church building, and the ground has been cleared. While the building is under construction, a growing number of people are coming to Christ and meeting in homes. Bassam's goal is to reach people for Christ, and he is doing that on a weekly basis.
