Due to circumstances beyond our control, the Haiti Bible Institute is once again homeless. The facility that God provided after the earthquake destroyed our old facility is no longer available for rent. The owner has put the building up for sale, so we must now find a new location. Because of the earthquake, suitable facilities are hard to come by, so please join us in prayer for this critical need.

The 2011 Modules for Cohort One are scheduled to be held April 13-20 (Module 5) and October 12-19 (Module 6). We would like to secure a suitable place for the school by January. In the past, God provided a new place when we needed one, and I am fully confident that He will do so again.
